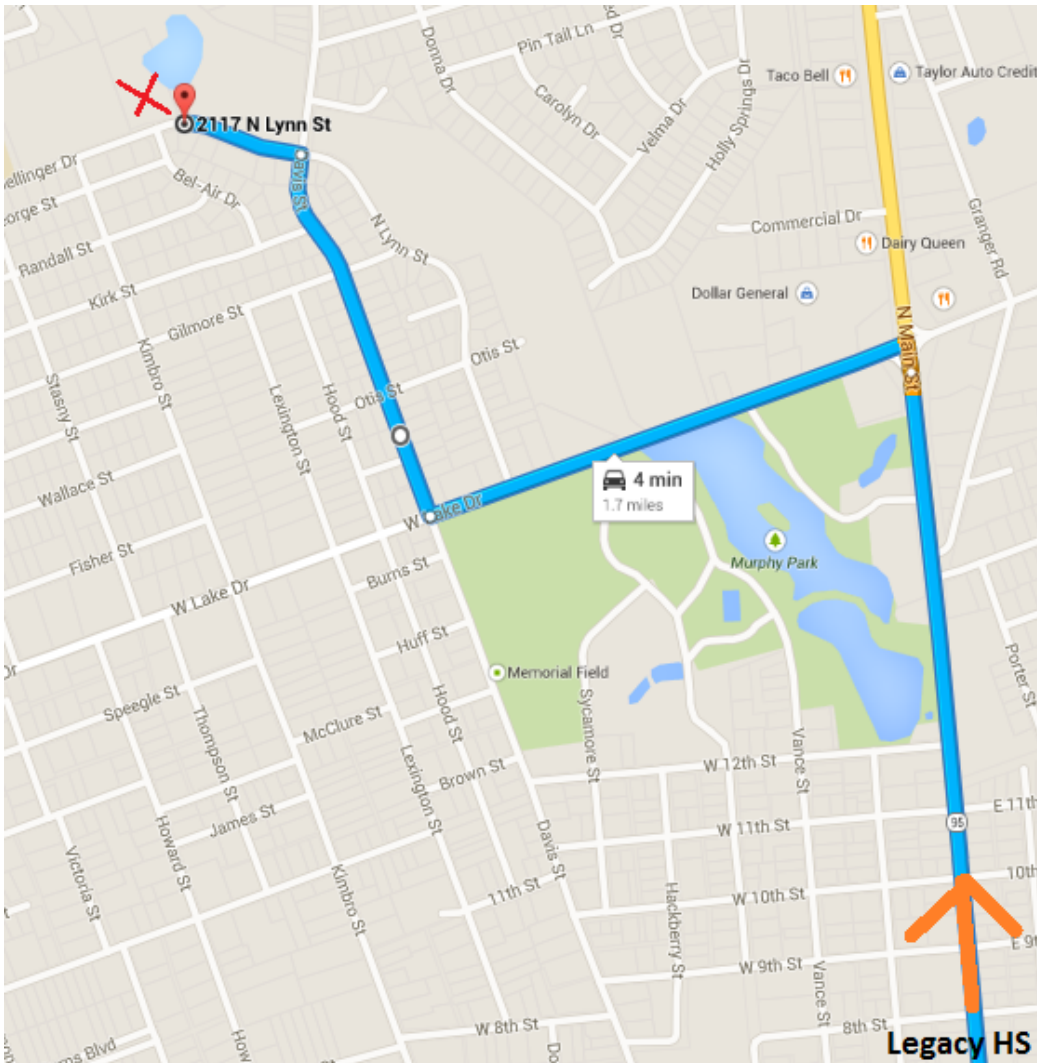


Dear Parent / Guardian,

As part of the B.L.A.D.E. (Beginners Learning Alternative Designs for Energy) club your son / daughter is participating in, we will begin on-site work for our project to install solar-powered lighting at the picnic table pavilion in Bull Branch park, Taylor.

Every Wednesday afterschool, your son / daughter will be transported by Taylor ISD van to Bull Branch park to work on the project. The van will depart Legacy HS around 3:55 pm on Wednesdays and arrive at the park about 10 minutes later.



There may be no transportation back to Legacy afterwards. You will need to arrange pickup of your child from the site location. Project work ends around 5:30 pm on Wednesdays.

Directions to the site:

1. From Legacy, head north on Main Street (right turn).
2. Turn left at the traffic lights for Lake Drive. There's a Walgreens and Sonic at the traffic lights.
3. Pass the tennis courts. Turn right on Davis street at the four-way stop sign.
4. You'll drive through a neighborhood and then see the park and softball field. Turn left on N. Lynn.
5. You'll see us at the pavilion!
